1. Rally Championship Review

- After discussion it was decided to not include Rally Nevada on the 2020 CRS Rally Championship, but to consider it for inclusion for 2021 if it runs successfully as an ARA event during 2020.
- The Prescott Rally will not take place during 2020, but is hoping to return in 2021.
- Erik & Mike B agreed to use the 2020 competition year to review the split between CRS-5 and CRS-2, and they will also include a general review of the CRS classes, with a recommendation prior to next year's BOG meeting.
- It was decided that organizers who receive organizer points but end up not competing during the
 year will have their organizer points removed at the end of the year. The 2019 Rally Championship
 points will be revised to reflect this process.
