

Fall 2020 BOG Meeting Minutes Sunday, Dec 6, 2020 (rev. 1 in Blue)

1. Rally Championship Review

- After discussion it was decided to add the Prescott Rally to the 2021 CRS Rally Championship as a coefficient 2/3 event.
- After discussion it was decided to add Rally Nevada to the 2021 CRS Rally Championship as a coefficient 2 event.
- Erik & Mike B agreed to continue their review of the split between CRS-5 and CRS-2, as well as a general review of the CRS classes, with a recommendation prior to next year's BOG meeting.
- Kurt and Samantha agreed to work together to put together a blurb & link to be used on event web sites to encourage CRS membership.
- Donnie will determine the best way to extract scoring data from the ARA system and then work with Mike G. to split super regional events into their respective CRS (single day) events for competitor display as well as for tabulating CRS standings.

3. Equipment Manager Report (Paula Gibeault)

- Paula was authorized up to \$450 to purchase new FRS radios for use at both Rallies and Rallycrosses.
- 4. Webmaster report and needs (Eddie Fiorelli)
 - Eddie agreed to document the needs for the current CRS web site, with an eye toward migrating to a more modern webmaster interface. Once this is complete Amy and Mike B. will investigate migration options.
- 5. Press Liaison Report (Erik Christiansen)
 - It was decided not to do the PR cards since our distribution options will be limited this year. The intention is to revisit this for 2022. Mike B. and Erik will design a digital flyer to replace it.

6. Membership Officers (Kurt Northrop & Lisa Strom)

• No issues at this time, however we need to make sure both Lisa & Kurt have enough CRS decals.

7. Class Compliance Officer (Donnie Smith)

• Since the Performance Stock Class rules are up for review at the end of 2021, Donnie will be seeking a methodology for improving the definition of the \$4,000 price limit in the rules.

8. BOG Officers for 2021

- All current BOG officers agreed to continue in their respective roles for 2021.
- It was also decided to NOT have elections for Director and Competitor Liaison since 2020 and 2021 form a single CRS super season.
- It was also decided to delete the Sponsor Liaison BOG officer since the rulebook will again be in a PDF format.

9. Rulebook plans

• For 2021 the rulebook will again be in a PDF format.

10. Rally School plans (Erik, Amy, Mike & Paula)

- Due to COVID considerations the classroom aspects of the Rally School will be done via Zoom, with PDFs of the charts provided to the students. The Zoom sessions will probably be done in the evenings over a number of days. Each Zoom classroom session will be followed with an interactive question and answer session. The classroom sessions will be recorded for later download by CRS members.
- A this time there will be no in-car driving or co-driving practice sessions, however there is a chance that these might take place later in the year as COVID conditions evolve.
- It was decided to buy a Zoom Pro account to support the Rally School as well as for BOG discussion and rally organizer use.

11. CRS Rallycross Calendar for 2021 (Sanjay Singh)

- Since 2020 and 2021 events will all be counted in the CRS RX super season it was decided to increase the number of CRS Rallycross events allowed at a given venue from 3 to 4 for this season (2020-2021).
- The initial remainder of the 2020-2021 CRS Rallycross Calendar will be developed during the next month. At this time it looks like:
 - o Glen Helen 3 or 4 CRS events
 - o Ridgecrest probably 2 events
 - o Thunderhill 3 events
 - Prairie City unknown at this time.
 - o Santa Rosa no events planned
